




EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, PERCENT OF PERSONS AGE 25+ (2011-2015)










PRIVATE SCHOOL AVERAGE TUITION (2015-2016)








HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN DUAL CREDIT PROGRAMS (CLASS OF 2016)
