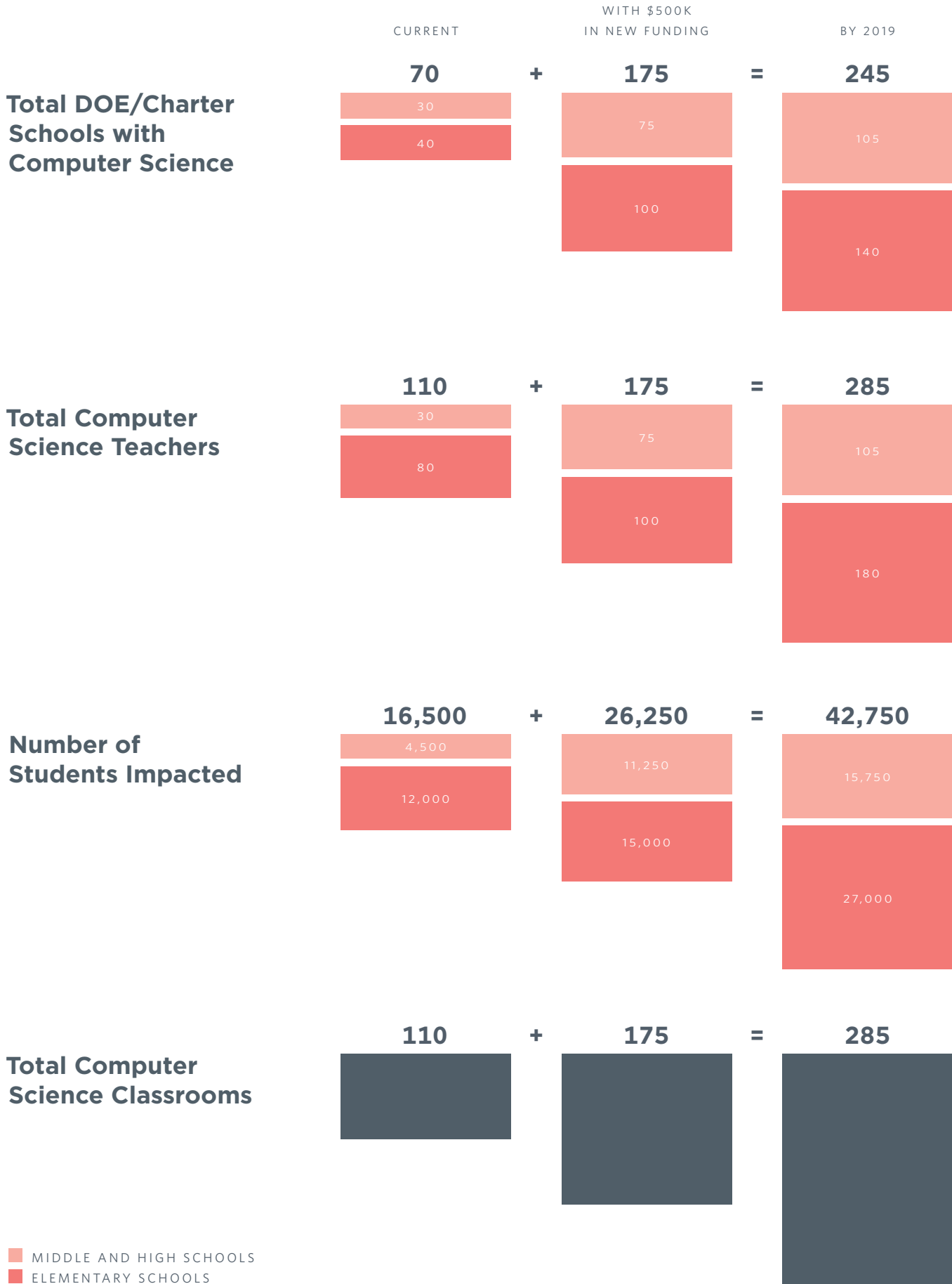


# The impact of \$500,000 in new funding for Computer Science in Hawaii.



**NOTES:** All of the above numbers are estimated and based on the following assumptions given available data: (1) twenty-percent of DOE/charter schools in Hawaii currently teach computer science, (2) in the current DOE/charter schools offering computer science, there are two elementary CS teachers per elementary school and one middle/high school CS teacher per middle/high school and (3) there are 150 students learning computer science per elementary school teacher (school librarian or computer teacher) and 150 students learning computer science per middle/high school CS teacher.
