



RACIAL DEMOGRAPHICS (2016 ESTIMATE)




MEDIAN INCOME (2011-2015)



PERSONS IN POVERTY (2016)






EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, PERCENT OF PERSONS AGE 25+ (2011-2015)





NUMBER OF TRADITIONAL PUBLIC, CHARTER AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS (2016-2017)



PRIVATE SCHOOL AVERAGE TUITION (2015-2016)




CHANGES IN K-12 STUDENT ENROLLMENT (2014-2017)




NUMBER OF SCHOOLS WITH PRE-K (2016)

NUMBER OF SCHOOLS MEETING STATE TARGETS IN READING AND MATH, ACCORDING TO STRIVE HI (2013-2016)




